LinkedIn 1 is for those who currently have a profile but are not sure what to do or are considering using LinkedIn in their job search. You will learn how to create a branded LinkedIn profile (to be found), why keywords matter (and where to put them) and how to write a meaningful invitation to connect. Requirements: Set up a LinkedIn account (it is free) before class. Please bring your LinkedIn email address and password and your resume to class.

LinkedIn 2 is for those who have a LinkedIn profile but want to know how to use the search tools, how and why to join groups, where to find jobs and be found by those searching for qualified candidates, how to re-search companies and how to market yourself. Requirements: Your LinkedIn profile should be at least 75% complete before attending.
